The Petition of the undersigned residents of the Sturt electorate and greater South Australia.

## **Argument**

We draw the attention of your Honourable House the great inconvenience suffered by the residents of Dernancourt and Highbury by the lack of action in installing traffic-lights at the area to the entrance of the Dernancourt Shopping Centre (840 Lower North East Road). The lack of traffic lights at this area causes many instances of dangerous driving including right and left-turns out of the shopping centre. Further, the lack of traffic lights causes a dangerous situation between pedestrians and motorists exiting the shopping centre.
